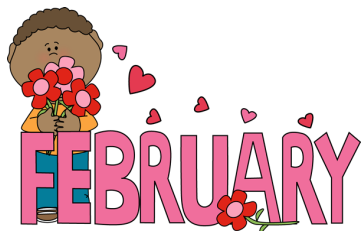

Feb. 5

Life Skills: Finding Information—Dictionaries, catalogues, internet, phone books, 911, location of important information, etc.

Feb. 12

Reading Skills: Personal Information—Name, address, telephone numbers, location of their paper identification, contact information

Life Skills: Valentine Love Tree—making and giving valentines, the history of Valentine’s Day

Feb. 19

Reading Skills: Sign Information—Signs in the community

Life Skills: Store Types: Grocery, laundry, drug store, restaurants, specialty, hairdresser/barber, recreation centers, etc.

Feb. 26
